Adderley Children Centre and Go-Woman! are delighted to offer First Steps - New Opportunities project; developed to encourage more people back into learning, through informal, short, fun and interactive taster sessions without the pressure of a long term commitment.



The project breaks the barriers to learning by addressing issues such as childcare and language support; two issues prohibiting women from accessing learning provisions in the community.

Free crèche facilities and language support are available to all participants.

All sessions are small in size ensuring that one-to-one support is available.

Sign posting resource has been set up to support learners to further learning provisions; through linkages with local provision providers, colleges and private institutions.

Internet Cafe has been setup, running every Friday between 1.30 and 5.30 allowing;

- free access to Internet facilities to search for information

- learners to practice current taster sessions

- additional modules will also be available for self learning

Internet Cafe is open to everyone in the community - fully facilitated by a member of staff.
